DeKalb County exports **\$133 million** in goods to Canada annually


Top DeKalb County goods exports to Canada

- Electrical Equipment & Components..... \$22 million
- Medical Equipment & Supplies..... \$20 million
- Engines & Turbines..... \$13 million
- Plastics Products..... \$9 million
- Communications Equipment..... \$6 million

DeKalb County exports **\$143 million** in services to Canada annually

Top DeKalb County services exports to Canada

- Charges for the use of intellectual property..\$42 million
- Business services.....\$33 million
- Telecommunications, computer & information services\$26 million
- Travel (including for education)..... \$22 million
- Insurance services..... \$13 million

- Agriculture..... 15%.....\$20 million
- Chemicals..... 5%.....\$6 million
- Equipment & machinery..... 42%.....\$56 million
- Plastics & rubbers..... 11%.....\$15 million
- Other..... 27%.....\$36 million
