**Christian County exports \$249 million in goods to Canada annually**

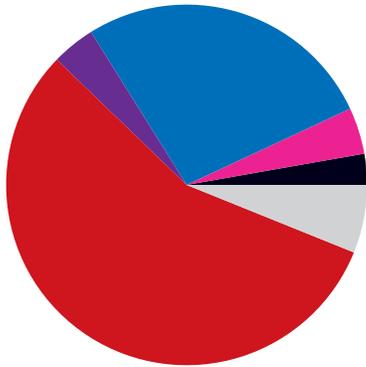
